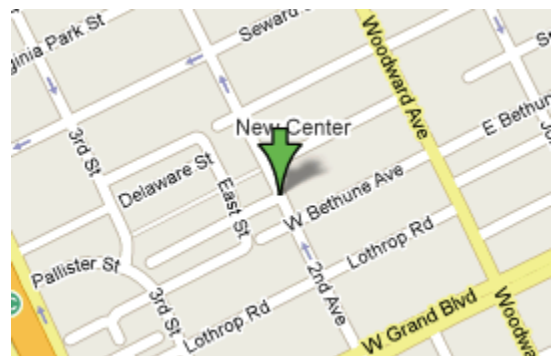

- **A valid e-mail address**
- **A valid Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer ID Number**

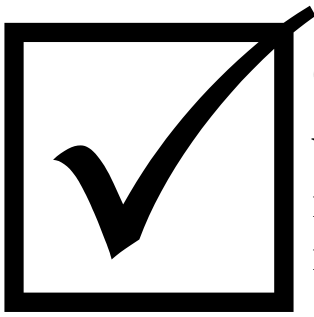
To file electronically, you need to verify your previous year's Adjusted Gross Income (on your income tax form) or your self-select PIN number that you used last year. If you don't have these, go to IRS.gov for Electronic Filing Pin Request or call the IRS at 1-800-829-1040.

CHECK LIST:

WHAT TO BRING FOR SELF-TAX PREPARATION

IDENTIFICATION/SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS

- ID: Driver's License or State ID
- Proof of Social Security numbers for yourself, spouse and each dependent

INCOME INFORMATION

All income statements and forms such as

- Form W2s, 1099R, 1099G
- A copy of last year's return, if available

EXPENSES YOU HAD THAT YOU MAY BE ABLE TO DEDUCT, *for example* . . .

- The purchase of a new home or vehicle
- Mortgage interest statement, property tax statement or rent receipts
- The purchase of energy efficient home appliances and improvements
- Medical expenses
- Dependent care expenses
- Student loan interest statement (1098-E), tuition statement (1098-T), and course materials

TO DIRECT DEPOSIT

- Bring your bank or credit union name, routing number and account number. *Direct deposit is the fastest and safest way to receive your refund.*

ACCOUNTING AID SOCIETY'S FREE TAX SITES FOR 2010

Accounting Aid Society is operating 25 free tax preparation locations in southeast Michigan through April 15. (*Only two of the 25 sites offer the self-tax preparation described on the reverse side.*)

At the locations below, trained Accounting Aid volunteers who are IRS-certified prepare federal, state and city income tax returns, and tax credits – including the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), the Michigan EITC, Federal Child Credit, Michigan Home Heating Credit, and the Michigan Homestead Property Tax Credit/Renter's Rebate.

Eligibility for this free service is based on annual household income: Individuals - annual household income up to \$25,000
Families - an annual household income up to 50,000 (*a married couple or a person with at least one dependent, for example*)

Each tax site has its own hours of operation. Many operate on a first come-first served basis, but some require appointments. A homebound tax program is also available for seniors and those physically unable to visit a tax site.
